In June 1984 they were #1 on the Billboard Charts! Opened the 1985 Grammy Awards with "The Heart of Rock and Roll." "The Power of Love" written for the movie Back to the Future, became #1 song and was even nominated for an Oscar. Also in 1985, the band participated in the USA for Africa recording of "We are the World." In 1986, received the BPI award for "Best International Artist of the Year" in London. Still touring internationally, fans eagerly await the release of the band's next new album.

Natalie Cole

For three decades, Natalie Cole has been one of our most treasured and successful vocal stylists. She has interpreted material from almost every genre, including contemporary pop, jazz, as well as R&B classics. She has been nominated for more than ten Grammy Awards, including being honored as "Best New Artist" in 1975.



Peter Frampton

A British teen idol shot to solo superstardom in the mid-'70. The guitarist joined the group Humble Pie for 2 years before departing for a solo career. After performing and touring with George Harrison, Frampton's LP went gold. His double album from "S.F.'s Winterland" sold over six million copies, producing 3 hit singles "Show Me the Way," "Baby, I Love Your Way," and "Do You Feel Like We Do". The follow-up LP, "I'm in You" produced Frampton's biggest hit in the title track. Frampton released a self-titled album for Relativity in 1994, followed by Frampton Comes Alive II in 1995. His debut for new label CMC International, "Live in Detroit" appeared in mid-2000.



Dionne Warwick

Dionne's career has been no less than phenomenal. A steady stream of hits, spanning over 3 decades, has made her one of the most respected and recognizable figures in music today. Always embracing new challenges and expanding her creative horizons, Dionne pours her energies into a multitude of professional and philanthropic endeavors. Her repertoire of talents continue to distinguish her as an international superstar.

Julio Iglesias

Julio's career is without precedent. He has released over 65 albums, sold more than 200 million copies and has been awarded more than 1,500 gold and platinum records worldwide. In addition, this Grammy winning singer has performed more than 3,000 concerts and appeared on more than 1,000 TV shows in 450 cities in 75 countries. He has recorded in many different languages including English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, Italian, and German.

Paula Abdul

In the wake of Madonna's success, many dance-pop divas filled the charts, but out of them all, Paula was the only one that sustained a career. From L.A. Lakers cheerleader to choreographer for Janet Jackson. After dancing on videos for ZZ top, Duran Ruran and the Pointer Sisters she was on her way to the top. Abdul's spectacular big-budget videos helped push the sales of "Forever Your Girl" past 7 million in the U.S. alone. Her 2nd album, 1991's Spellbound, sold over 3 million. Abdul released her third album, "Head Over Heels" in the summer of 1995.



Bruce Hornsby

Mainstream America knows Bruce Hornsby from 8 or 9 hit songs from 1986-90, but in truth the story goes far deeper; His career since has been one of constantly expanding his musical boundaries, developing and improving his talents on every musical level, and compiling a singularly impressive list of collaborations, credits, and disparate musical ventures. "There's a different groove sense now," Hornsby says. "It just brought out a looser, more soulful side of me — certainly vocally and probably a bit on the piano, too. The vocal thing, to me, is what I think is the big difference here. I've always been gradually loosening up over the years; you listen to 'Spirit Trail' and then you listen to 'The Way It Is' and you go "Man, it's a different guy singing.' And that, really, has to do with the different feeling I get from the rhythm section in my band.'
