Jay Leno

Following in the footsteps of legendary NBC late-night hosts Steve Allen, Jack Paar and Johnny Carson is Jay Leno, host of the Emmy Award-winning and top-rated "The Tonight Show with Jay Leno." Celebrating his tenth anniversary in May 2002, Leno has created his own unique late-night style with a combination of humor, talk and entertainment each night at 11:35 p.m. – the wee hours when viewers want to wind down with a few laughs before drifting off to

dreamland.

Dana Carvy

Known for "SATURDAY NIGHT LIVE" since the 1986-92, his characters the Church Lady; Hans, of the Hans and Franz bodybuilding duo began. Also Garth, from "Wayne's World," and well known for his political figures as Ex-President George Bush. He hosted the 1992 MTV Music Awards, costarred in numerous Shotime and HBO specials. In 1993 won an Emmy Award for Outstanding Individual Performance in a Variety or Music Program and a total of six Emmy nominations. Also, he was honored with the American Comedy Award as Television's Funniest Supporting Male in 1990 and 1991.



Bob Newhart

Bill Cosby

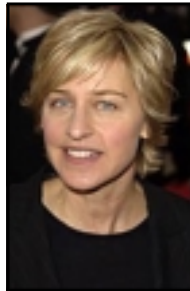
Bill Cosby is, by any standards, one of the most influential stars in America today. Whether it be through concert appearances or recordings, television or films, commercials or education, Bill Cosby has the ability to touch people's lives. His humor often centers on the basic cornerstones of our existence, seeking to provide an insight into our roles as parents, children, family members, and men and women. With over thirty years in comedy, Bill Cosby is for many young comedians the man who wrote the textbook. During the mid-sixties, Cosby had as many as six albums on the charts at one time. Eight of the albums have been certified Gold Records by the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA).

Jeff Foxworthy

In addition to being a successful stand-up comedian, actor and recording artist, Jeff is also the author of three best selling books. In 1990 he captured the American Comedy Award for "Stand-Up Comic of the Year." ABC premiered "The Jeff Foxworthy Show" from 95 to 97. In 2002, Foxworthy joined comedians Bill Engvall, Larry the Cable Guy and Ron White for the "Blue Collar Comedy Tour." The tour was later taped and filmed as a concert movie in 2003.
