Along the way, the group racked up a string of gold and platinum albums in the US, along with a number of radio hits like "Listen to the Music," "Black Water", "China Grove...and more.

Creedence Clearwater Revisited

Creedence Clearwater Revival's distinctive rock captured the imagination of the pop world - the songs made great three minute radio gems - and the more politicized subculture, they successfully bridged the gap between the underground and mainstream audiences. Writer Greil Marcus wrote that "rarely in rock and roll history has there been so close a relation between creative achievement and audience response." Creedence Clearwater Revisited's RECOLLECTION adds a new chapter to that legacy with the vibrant American spirit and exhilarating energy inherent in the songs.

Chicago

Chicago's first self-titled album sold over two million copies and spawned four chart singles, beginning a string of massive hits that lasted to the end of the decade, with each album cover sporting a variation on the Chicago logo and a sequential title with a roman numeral: Chicago II, Chicago III, etc. Chicago's music was a combination of many varying styles, from hard rock to light pop, and often included elements of jazz and classical.

The Surf City Allstars were formed in the early 80's when Jan Berry couldn't always perform with Jan & Dean, due to occasional health problems. The Allstars are now a full time endeavor for Dean and the band. The Surf City Allstars are the best surfin' beach party band around on a par with their friends, the Beach Boys. Each member has had a long career in surf and beach music. When you hear the band, you get Dean Torrance singing all the Jan & Dean hits; Surf City, Little Old Lady from Pasadena, Drag City, Deadman's Curve, etc. as well as the songs that Dean sang with the Beach Boys, such as Barbara Ann.

Mary Wilson Of The Supremes

Mary Wilson is a living legend. A member of the world-renowned Supremes, one of the greatest female vocal groups of all time, Mary Wilson has been the only original Supreme carrying on the group's legacy to this day. Representing the group, Mary accepted the Lifetime Achievement Award for the Supremes at their induction into the Rock 'N Roll Hall of Fame, becoming the second female rock star to be its recipient.
